PREAMBLE :

Read: Notification of NCTE, New Delhi dated 01.01.2004 published in the Gazette of India Part III – Section 4 as No.3 on 05.01.2004

The NCTE, New Delhi in its Notification dated 01.01.2004 decided to dispense with the requirement of "No Objection Certificate" from State/UT Government for those institutions already running B.Ed programmes recognised by NCTE and seeking recognition to start a course or training in Elementary Teacher Education for a period of three years from the date of notification of these regulations in the Official Gazette.

The Mahabubnagar Educational Society, Mahabubnagar, Andhra Pradesh is running Adarsh College of Teacher Education, Venkateswara Colony, Mahabubnagar, Andhra Pradesh which has been granted recognition by SRC-NCTE. It has submitted an application to start Elementary (D.Ed) course by deriving the benefit of above said regulation on 03.02.2004.

The application for starting Adarsh College of Elementary Teacher Education, Venkateswara Colony, Mahabubnagar-509001, Andhra Pradesh was considered by SRC-NCTE under Section 15 of NCTE Act, 1993. Accordingly, inspection of the institution was carried out on 29.04.2005 and the report of inspection team and other documents furnished by the institution along with the application were considered by the Southern Regional Committee in its meeting held on 19-20 July, 2005. The Regional Committee observed that the institution has made satisfactory arrangements in respect of infrastructural and instructional facilities for starting D.Ed course and decided to permit the institution to start Elementary (D.Ed) course from the session 2005-05.

Hence the order.

ORDER

In terms of Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Mahabubnagar Educational Society, Mahabubnagar, Andhra Pradesh had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE seeking permission to start Adarsh College of Elementary Teacher Education, Venkateswara Colony, Mahabubnagar-509001, Andhra Pradesh for Elementary(D.Ed) Course of two years duration from the academic session 2005-06 with an annual intake of 50 students.

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2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:
 - a. The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
 - b. The institution has made arrangements for conducting the course in the rented premises.
 - c. The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs.5 lakhs and a Reserve Fund of Rs. 2.5 lakhs.
 - d. The institution has identified the Principal and five teachers for the said course.
3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants permission to start Adarsh College of Elementary Teacher Education, Venkateswara Colony, Mahabubnagar-509001, Andhra Pradesh for Elementary (D.Ed) course of two years duration from the academic session 2005-2006 with an annual intake of 50 students subject to fulfillment of the following.
 - a. The institution will ensure that Principal and Five faculty members duly approved by the Director, SCERT, Hyderabad are in position for an intake of 50 students before commencement of admissions and a copy of approved staff list shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately and in any case before commencement of the admissions.
 - b. The institution shall, within three months of the receipt of recognition order, convert the Endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Southern Regional Committee.
 - c. The institution shall shift both B.Ed & D.Ed courses to its own premises / building within three years from the date of recognition of B.Ed college as the recognition for D.Ed is issued based on existence of B.Ed college and Notification dated 01.01.2004 of NCTE. (in case the B.Ed / D.Ed course is started in rented premises).
 - d. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.

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4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like the State Government etc.
5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the Director, SCERT, Hyderabad to the appointment of faculty members and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the Provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Mahabubnagar Educational Society, Plot No. 7-5-51/C, Venkateshwara Colony Road, Mahabubnagar Village and Post, Mahabubnagar, City and Taluk, Mahabubnagar District- 509001, Andhra Pradesh had submitted an on-line application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE on 27.09.2011 and physical application on 29.09.2011 for grant of recognition for D.El.Ed-AI course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students at Adarsh College of Elementary Teacher Education, Plot/Khasara No.136/A, Malleboinpally Village and Post, Jadcherla Taluk, Mahbubnagar District – 509301, Andhra Pradesh.

AND WHEREAS, on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, the committee is satisfied that the institution fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the said teacher education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratories etc., for running the programme and has appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to Adarsh College of Elementary Teacher Education, Plot/Khasara No.136/A, Malleboinpally Village and Post, Jadcherla Taluk, Mahbubnagar District – 509301, Andhra Pradesh for conducting D.El.Ed-AI Course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students, from the academic session 2012-2013 under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009 subject, to fulfillment of the following conditions:

- I. The endowment fund of Rs.5 lakhs and reserve fund of Rs.3 lakhs kept in joint account with SRC, NCTE should be maintained always. Loan raising or mortgaging of FDRs shall not be done.
 - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
 - III. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.
 - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
2. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.
 3. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

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4. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-
 - a) Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution;
 - b) Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph;
 - c) Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last , quarter;
 - d) Names of students admitted during the current session along with qualification, percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
 - e) Fee charged from students;
 - f) Available infrastructural facilities;
 - g) Facilities added during the last quarter;
 - h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
 - i) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires
 - j) Any wrong or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition
5. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
